PEOPLE - experience intergenerational friendships and build community with those you live with, and those you encounter in the neighborhoods you work, live and play in.

PLACE - invest in Port Orchard, find a place to call your own, know your neighbors, and

EXPERIENCE THE PRESENCE OF GOD - practice both communal and individual disciplines to grow closer to God and root your faith

This looks like:

- Sharing life, eating, learning and praying with housemates, mentors and local faith leaders one night a week

- Worshiping with a local congregation
- Practicing Sabbath* weekly
